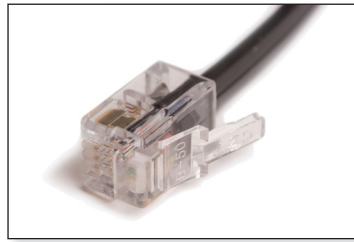

USB-B Connector & Status LED.

Tri-colour LED indicates when the device is detected by PC, correct Handset Selector Switch position and recording activity.



Telephone Plug.

4-Way Modular Plug connects into your telephone handset socket. (Length 300mm)



Handset Socket.

4-Way Modular socket allows connection of your telephone handset or headset.



USB-B to USB-A Cable.

(Supplied) USB cable to allow connection of your Recording Adaptor to your PC. (Length 1.5m)



Handset Selector Switch.

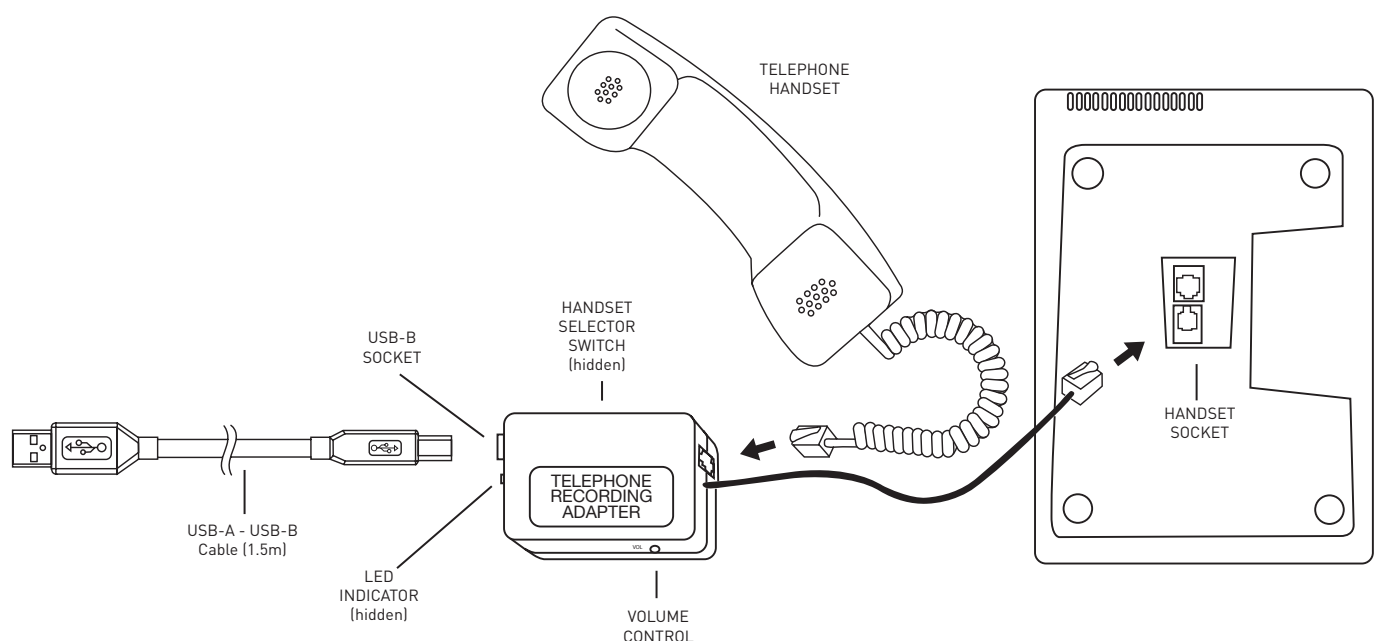
Selects the correct handset wiring type to suit your telephone.



Volume Control.

Allows you to balance the volume of your voice with the other party's voice.
